Spring Grove Cemetery records show that Mrs. Hannah Lewis is interred in the same space (Space #1) as is Alex P Lewis. I am speculating that Hannah is Alex's mother. She was moved to this location Section 72 Lot 51 in 1900 from her previous single grave. This was the same time that Alex was moved to this location, having been buried in the same coffin. This must have occurred after Sarah purchased this plot in anticipation of bringing the family together at Spring Grove.

Frederick Knoblauch was also moved to this plot a little later in 1905. Section 72 Lot 51 Space 3.

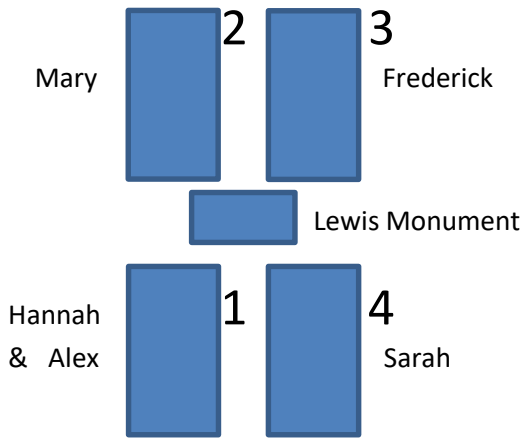

The front of the above marker is shown, which faces Sarah and Alex. I am not sure if I looked at the back side of it to see if there was engraved the information on Frederick and Mary on that side. I know there were no flat ground markers, for I checked all of those. I will return to verify.

The back of the monument is bare.

Frederick's wife, Mary J Knoblauch was laid to rest in 1904 in a public vault and then moved to Section 72 Lot 51 Space #2, next to her husband on the same day, April 1, 1905. These are Armand's grandparents.



As to Mary J. Knoblauch, nee Lewis, Sarah's sister, well she married Frederick Knoblauch and apparently stayed with him until his death in 1886.
