#### Notes:

#### **Johann Georg Schwartz**

Johann George Schwartz and wife Maria Catherine Schweig were members of the Lancaster PA congregation of the Moravian Church. George was born in Neckargemund, Germany, about 10 mi. east of Heidelberg.

Johann George came to America in 1743 aboard the ship Neptune. Three Schwartzes were listed as passengers, perhaps they were older children but our Jacob and bro. George were born after the ships arrival.

This couple had 10 children according to the Burial Book of the Moravian Church in Lancaster, PA (1744-1821). Five died before George and their names are not given. However we did find that one of those children was Johann Heinrich who died at age 6. The 5 surviving children were Jacob, George, Susanna, Catharina and Anna Maria. At the time of his death, Anna Maria was still single at age 30.

From the book "The Practice of Pluralism" by Mark Hdberlein, " The saddler Johann Georg Schwartz, a native of Neckargemund in the Palatinate who had come to America in 1743 and joined the Moravians when he was in his late twenties, remained a faithful member of the United Brethren until his death in 1800, more than half a century after the schism occurred in the Lutheran congregation." also " When the quaker Isaac Whitelock got the Moravian Johann Georg Schwartz into debtor's prison, several council members pledged to help Schwartz get rid of his debts.

#### **Susanna Schwartz**

#### **Jacob Schwartz**

Jacob Schwartz was the son of Johann George Schwartz and Catherine Schweig Schwartz. They were members of the Lancaster, PA congregation of the Moravian Church. Jacob Schwartz served in the American Revolution. ON June 27, 1781 he resided with the district of the 8th Battalion, Lancaster Co. Militia, subject to the Militia Law, 2nd Co. 8th class (Pa Archives, 5th Series, VI, 830)

According to the history of Jackson Co. IL published in 1878, this Jacob Schwartz was indeed the father of our Illinois Schwartzes. However, the history states that Jacob and Catherine Kimmel Schwartz, both born in Lancaster Co. PA, came to Illinois in 1817 with their family. However, the article from the Laurel Co. Messenger, a genealogical paper of Somerset Co. PA, Jacob Schwartz is buried in Somerset Co. PA. It is not clear if he went and returned, or never went.

**Notes: (con't)**

(Later found in "History of Illinois", that Jacob Schwartz being in ill health, never went to Illinois but remained behind with his daughter, Josephine Dively in Pennsylvania. This is the first I've heard of Josephine, perhaps it was Juliana. The book says Catherine Kimmel Schwartz came down the Ohio River on a flat boat with 8 of her children ub 1817)  
Some speculate that Jacob was a bit "tetched". He had a lawsuit against his wife's father, George Kimmel. There was some unclear trouble over a house as well. Perhaps Somerset Co. records could clear it up, if they can be found.
